Inspection frequency: All systems shall be inspected visually by the user prior to each use. The Malta Dynamics X500 shall be inspected by a competent person other than the end user annually. More frequent inspections could be necessary do to environment or company policies.



Detailed inspection records shall be kept. In the event this system has been involved in a fall, the XSERIES unit and all components must be removed from service immediately and checked by a trained and competent person before possibly being put back in service.

- 1. Begin at the front of the machine, rotate the mast 360 degrees checking for any corrosion or missing bolts connecting the mast to the weighted base.
- 2. Check to make sure all bolts are still torqued to spec stated in the user manual.
- 3. Proceed around the machine inspecting welds for cracks or gaps. Cracks in the paint may help identify these areas.
- 4. Ensure that the leveling jacks show no sign of wear or damage.
- 5. Inspect the anchor points for deformation, cracks, and that they rotate freely.

Corrective actions: If damage is found or questionable conditions are apparent, remove the equipment from service immediately and tag DO NOT USE.
